## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Before being allowed to register in our French second language methods courses (ED 3562, ED 4568, ED 4567, ED 4569), you must possess a high level of oral and written French proficiency. Consequently, BEFORE ATTENDING CLASS, you must submit to L2RIC (Room 346, Marshall d'Avray Hall) a *Certificate of Oral Proficiency* from the Department of Education of New Brunswick attesting to a minimum level of *Advanced*. (A photocopy will suffice.)

PLEASE NOTE: Before doing your Advanced Practicum (March-May), you must provide your *Certificate of Oral Proficiency* indicating a minimum level of *Advanced* for Intensive French and post-Intensive French, and a minimum of *Advanced Plus* for Immersion. You must also demonstrate a high level of written language competence in course assignments.

## CERTIFICATE IN TEACHING FRENCH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (CTFSL)

This certificate is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to become effective teachers of French as a Second Language (FSL). The CTFSL requires successful completion of:

1. Three required courses according to the program:

Secondary: ED 3562, ED 4567, ED 4075

Elementary: ED 4568, ED 4569, ED 4075

2. An extended practicum (Advanced Practicum) in an FSL context (minimum 50%)

3. The New Brunswick *Certificate of Oral Proficiency* (minimum of *Advanced Plus* for French Immersion, and *Advanced* for all other FSL teaching contexts – e.g. Intensive French)

Eligibility:

Eligibility: In order to enrol in the CTFSL, candidates must be currently enrolled in the BEd program and be completing a concentration in FSL. Candidates must also complete the certificate application form found on-line and bring it to the L2RIC office (346 Marshall d'Avray Hall). Blank forms are also available at the office.
