Fall Semester Dates

Preferred arrival date:	Early September
Orientation:	Early September, usually 4 days
Classes start and finish:	Early September- early December
Exams start and finish:	2 weeks in December

Winter Semester Dates

Classes start and finish:	Early January – Early April
Winter term break:	First week of March
Exams start and finish:	2 weeks in April

Type of housing available:	Suite, Special Single, Single, Special Double, Double, Multiple rooms and off-campus housing (see http://www.unb.ca/housing for more information). Off-campus facilities also available but students need to find these on their own.
Residence: Housing and food cost estimate/term	\$3,500-\$4,800 CAD
Residence: Housing application deadline:	Priority is given to those who apply first. It is best to apply by early June for the fall term and early October for the winter term.
Off Campus Housing: Housing and food cost estimate (for a term)	\$2,500-\$4,500 CAD
