The UNB Fredericton Residence Community provides residence for 1,700 students including the following options: **Traditional Undergraduate Residences:** With full res life activities and support, these residences cater to both new and returning undergraduate students offering a variety of lifestyles (female, coed, male) and all services (ResNet, cable TV, local phone). First-year students are normally assigned to double rooms with single rooms being assigned to upper level (or special needs) students. Dining plans are mandatory (plans include both structured meals and discretionary retail dining cash) except for Maggie Jean Chestnut Residence (communal kitchens – dining plans optional). **Suite-Style Residence (Fall 2006):** With 2- and 3-bedroom furnished suites with kitchens, baths and living rooms, this new residence caters to single senior undergraduate, 2nd degree, and graduate students wanting more independent living. Students may apply as a group (to fill a suite) or singularly (to be matched with others). Given its clientele, this residence involves a 12-month commitment, ResNet/Cable TV, and no full dining plan but a \$300 – \$500 dining commitment may be required. **Magee Apartment Building:** With 1-, 2- and 3-bedroom full apartments (appliances only), Magee caters to student families and mature single students wanting the independence and lifestyle normally found in apartment buildings. Given this fact, Magee has 12-month leases, rents by the apartment (no matching of single students), its own application process, and dining plans are optional. Heat but no other services are included.

I am prepared to accept any room which may be allocated to me, although I understand that consideration will be given to the preferences I have expressed on this form. **I further understand that a \$300 residence deposit and a \$100 damage deposit are required, payable when offered admission to UNB.** I realize that this residence deposit is only partially refundable if cancelled in writing by July 31 (\$150 refund) or August 21 (\$50 refund) with the entire deposit being forfeited after August 21 or if I do not use the reserved accommodation. The damage deposit is fully refundable before entering residence or refundable **less any damage charges when leaving residence.**
