

Harassment/Stalking

If you are being harassed through: continuous phone calls; persistent e-mails (cyberstalking); or being followed around, you should do the following: make written note of date, time, place, location and content of the message (event), on each and every occasion. Tell the person not to contact you again, and call Campus Security or City Police. Keep track of the messages, save them, print them out and turn them over to appropriate authorities.

Cyber stalking is not a game and continuous harassment or stalking is a criminal offence.
